

School-Uniform Policy

- Pupils should wear the school uniform each day. This consists of a red v-neck jumper, red tie, a white blouse, navy skirt, pinafore or trousers. The school crest is a vital part of the uniform. **On PE days only**, the school **red and navy blue tracksuit** should be worn with a red or white polo shirt. **No Jewellery is permitted during P.E.**
- All parts of uniform should be clearly marked with child's name.
- Parents are notified if children are wearing the incorrect uniform or repeatedly wearing tracksuit on non-PE days. The pupils will be given a uniform to wear in this instance.
- A formal letter will be sent home in the event of a child repeatedly not wearing the correct uniform and parent/guardians will be requested to meet the principal to discuss the issue.

- Hair should be tied back.
- Make-up, nail-varnish, false nails , fake tan and false eyelashes are not allowed.
 - Children will be sent to the office to get remover if appropriate
 - Children will be asked to sit on the bench in the link corridor / detention during lunch if they come to school with nail varnish/ make up that cannot be removed.
- The only jewellery permitted is: one pair of stud earrings and/or a watch
- ***We would ask for Full co-operation in helping to implement the above policy.***
